Hello!

I'm looking forward to making the Buzzed Birds Quilt with you. This is a fun quilt that celebrates the traditional Birds In the Air block while putting a modern spin on it. It looks great in any fabric due to the classic shapes included so have fun raiding your stash or buying new fabric! I've included a coloring sheet for you at the end of this so you can start to play and plan for your quilt.

In this class we will work on making the Buzzed Birds Lap Quilt. You will learn tips and tricks for Foundation Paper Piecing and we will chat a bit about color selection and balance. After we play with Foundation Paper Piecing I will share with you several pattern hacks that will make this pattern much for versatile for future projects.

Fabric Requirements:

Block Fabric	22 Fat Quarters OR 22 - 1/4 yd pieces
Background 1	2 yds
Background 2	2 yds

Note: if you choose there will be enough left over from the Block Fabric Fat Quarters to piece your quilt back!

Supplies Needed:

- Scotch tape
- Rotary cutter
- Acrylic ruler
- Cutting mat
- Add a Quarter ruler OR small ruler (2 1/2" x 8 1/2" is ideal)
- Seam roller or creaser
- Thread for piecing
- Paper scissors (or rotary cutter dedicated to cutting paper)
- Flat head pins
- Sheet of template plastic, index card, or sheet of card stock
- Optional: Portable Lightbox
- Sewing Machine
- Basic Sewing Supplies
