# Clam Toss Quilt

Hello,

I'm looking forward to our Clam Toss Quilt class. Here is a bit of pre-work and a few ideas to make our class more effective. Also there are a few pages of layout ideas and coloring pages. The class is designed for you to make a Clam Toss Quilt using either the The Clammy™ 8", 10", or 12". Save the 6" to play with after the class! If this is your first time sewing curves, then I suggest the 12". Trust me - it is much easier!

This class uses the Clam Toss Quilt Pattern and either the 8", 10" or 12" The Clammy™ templates and the Clam Toss Quilt pattern. You can purchase your template and pattern directly from the Stitchin Post - <https://stitchinpost.com/>.

The pattern includes baby through king sized layouts and you can make any size that you would like. Note that the only quilts that *may* be finished in class will be a baby sized quilt and maybe the lap sized if you're working on a 12". But, you will get a lot done on larger sizes and will go home confident enough in the technique to be able to finish your quilt easily.

## Pre-Work

Your pre-work before class is to **cut out your whole clamshells and pre-cut your left and right pieces**. This can take awhile and I don't want your whole class to be spent cutting out clamshells. If you can't cut them all out, then at least cut out 15 - 20. If you would like you can cut the left and right sides but I'll also show you how in class.

	Whole Clams (W)	# Left & Right Pre-Cut Pieces (6½" x 12½")
BABY (50" x 60")	49	22
THROW (60" x 70")	71	26
TWIN (70" x 90")	110	32
FULL (90" x 100")	161	38
QUEEN (100" x 110")	199	41
KING (110" x 110")	220	44

### 8" Clam Toss

	Whole Clams (W)	# Left & Right Pre-Cut Pieces (6½" x 12½")
BABY (48" x 56")	71	26
THROW (64" x 72")	127	34
TWIN (72" x 96")	195	42
FULL (88" x 96")	241	46
QUEEN (96" x 104")	287	50
KING (104" x 104")	312	52

If in fact you get to class and don't have pre-work done or you waited too late to purchase your Clammy template then we'll have patterns and templates in class. Just note, that you'll spend the first hour or more of precious class time cutting.

## Layout

Classrooms generally have limited space for layout but, if you need layout assistance, feel free to cut out enough to start to lay your quilt out and we will work on layout in class before you start to sew. On the next few pages are some layout ideas for you to think about. Also, there are several coloring sheets for your use.

# Supplies for Class

## Supplies:

The Clammy™ 8", 10" or 12"

Estimated TOTAL Fabric required: - Baby: 4 yds; Throw: 7 yds; Twin: 10 yds; Full: 12 yds;

Queen: 14 yds; King: 16 yds

Coordinating thread for piecing

A few straight pins

28mm Rotary Cutter (especially for the 8" Clammy™)

Cutting Mat

Small Acrylic Ruler - 12.5" Long is ideal

## Optional Supplies:

1/4" foot with flange for your sewing machine - **strongly suggested**

Knee lift - if your machine has one bring it

Stiletto (like The Purple Thing)

Tweezers

## Clam Toss Layout Ideas

There are MANY options for the layout of your Clam Toss quilt! Here are a few ideas. Use the coloring pages at the end to play and come up with your own layouts! A random fabric arrangement is the easiest especially if you haven't laid out your quilt before class!

The cover quilt is pretty random with one fabric that creates a lot of negative space.

Diagonal rows! This is a great layout also for an ombre effect or for a gradation of colors.

Pick two of your favorite fabrics!

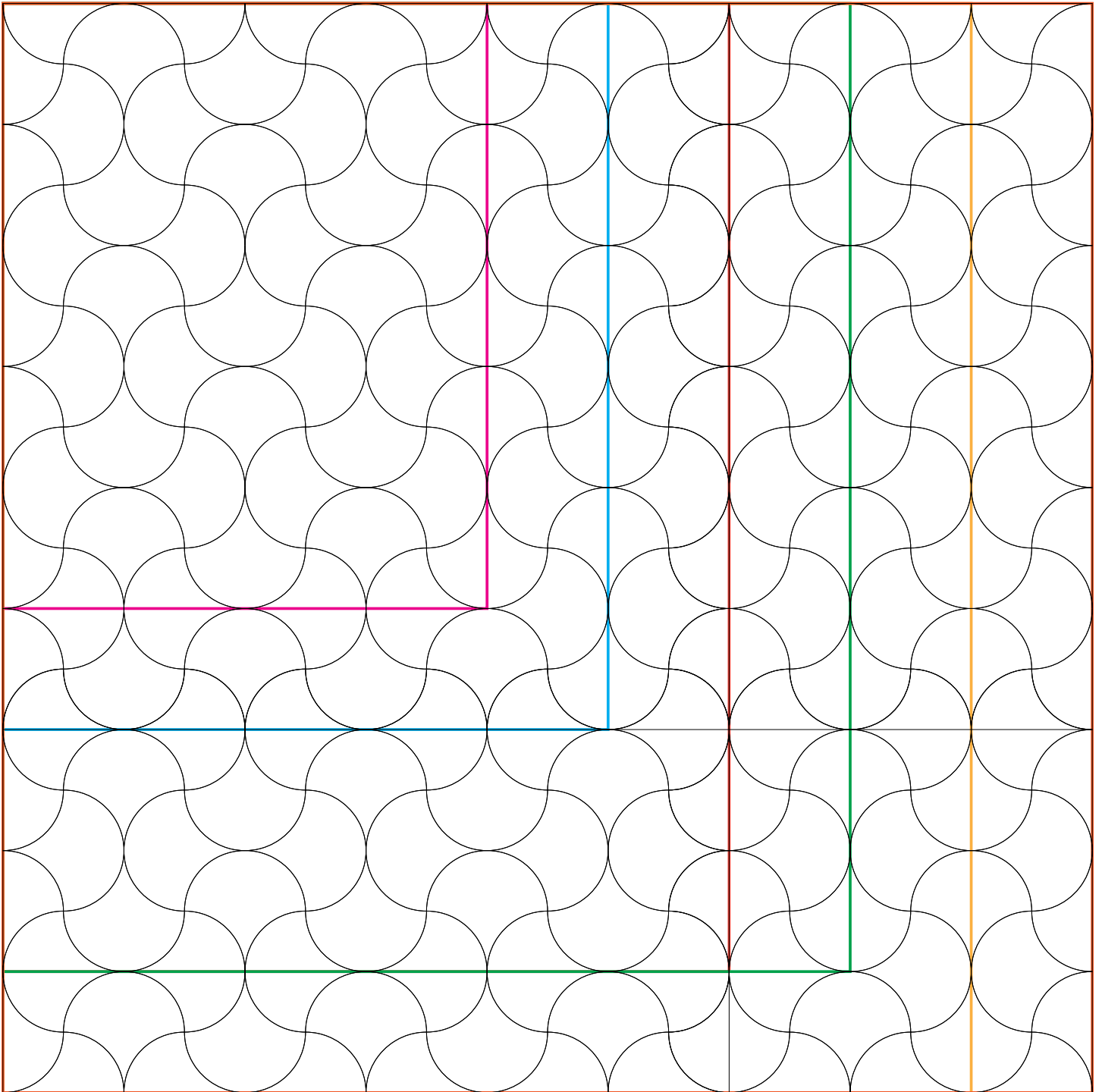


Chinese lantern layout.



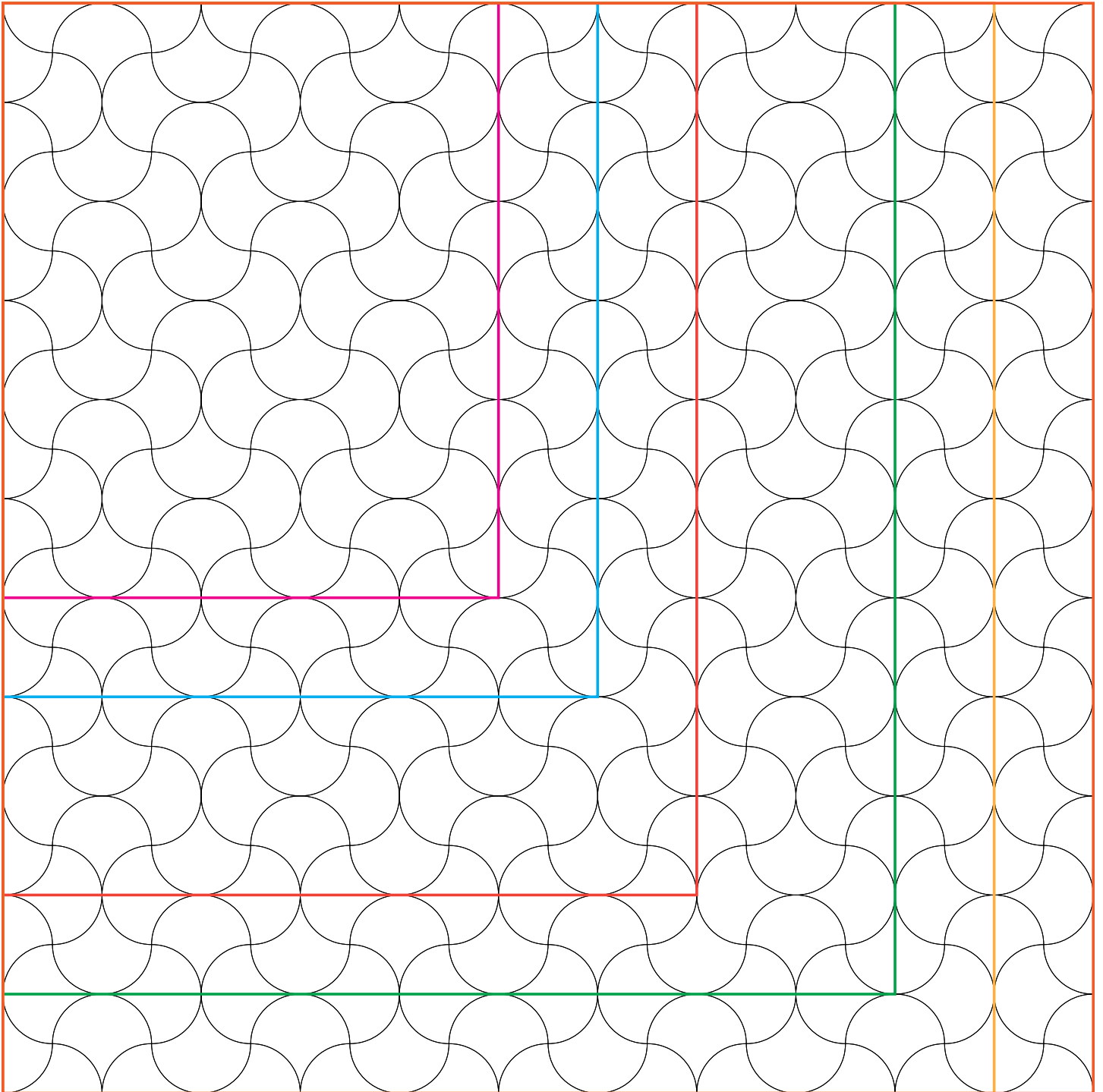
