CLASS LEVEL - ALL

WORKSHOP DESCRIPTION

Just the title, "Dwellings" conjures up so many possibilities. Imagine creating a small piece inspired by travels, hometown, dream house or anything else that might come to mind. Using wool and cotton hand applique along with decorative stitching/embroidery there are endless ways to express your creativity. There will be several samples shared in class and little exercises to ignite everyone's "inner architect" while constructing an original and unique project.

INSTRUCTIONS

If you have projects from any of our previous collaborative classes, PLEASE bring them to share with the group!!

SUPPLY LIST

- Sewing Machine (If you choose to piece the background.)
- Basic Sewing Supplies:
 - o Rotary Cutter, Ruler & Mat
 - o Scissors/Fabric and Paper
 - o Pencil and Glue Stick for paper (any brand)
- Freezer Paper
- Notebook (optional)
- Portable Light for close up hand stitching
- Applique Pins
- Needles: #24 Chenille #18 Chenille #1 & #3 Milliners #10 or #11 Straw Needle
- Ellana Wool Threads and Cotton Threads for Applique
- An assortment of Embellishment Threads
- WOOL: Bring at least 3 fat 1/8th's of varying textures in the colors you would like to do the background out of. This way you can choose to piece them to make a larger background or create smaller pieces. Also bring other scraps of wool for some of the shapes you will add to the background.
- COTTON: Bring a variety to choose from to add texture and spice!
- Stitchin' Post will have a wide selection of the wool and cottons available for purchase.

CANCELLATIONS: Cancellation must be made **45 days** prior to the first day of class for a refund, less a \$25 non-refundable registration deposit. Cancellation less than 45 days before the first day of class forfeits all registration monies paid. On occasion, Stitchin' Post will cancel a class due to lack of registration. If Stitchin' Post cancels this class, you may take a store credit or a refund. To minimize the chance that you will purchase your fabrics and supplies prior to a class that could cancel, we recommend that you call to confirm that the class has met its minimum enrollment and will go on as scheduled. Our recommendation is that you make class purchases within 45 days of the class start date.
