CLASS LEVEL - ALL

WORKSHOP DESCRIPTION

Have you ever wanted to create your own fabric on the computer but were not sure how to go about it? Using just a few simple-to-follow techniques, we will explore my own photo-editing tricks with one of your own photos and a variety of layers such as DIY scribbles or marks.

Day 1 – You will design and print several images onto fabric

Day 2 – You will use your self-designed and printed fabric to create a work or art or your own virtual collage for a simple wall hanging.

The instructor will facilitate transformation of items such as interesting images, favorite photos, surface design products, and scribbles/doodles into an original and personal piece of digital art that can be printed onto fabric or paper and included in your next art quilt.

INSTRUCTIONS

There will be a materials fee of \$15 that will include general supplies such as an assortment of pre-backed and cut fabrics such as linen, silks, and cottons as well as the printing of that fabric. It will also include a selection of papers that can be printed on and used in an art quilt. The instructor will also provide several designs for experimentation.

SUPPLY LIST

- Paper or card stock for drawing and/or mark making
- Various drawing instruments such as a Sharpie pen, No. 2 pencil, or color markers
- Drawings from sketchbooks or journals as well as gel prints or mixed media compositions and collages that can be (or have been) digitized
- Inspirational photos you might want to work with, such as landscapes, flowers, or quilts
- Something to quickly create digital images. I generally use my phone because it is easy to transfer photos to my computer. To that end, a flash drive might also be helpful already digitized images

KEEP GOING...THERE'S MORE...

Optional – NOT REQUIRED

- Laptop computer with fairly recent version of Photoshop Elements (PSE) (for example, PSE 14, 15, 2018, or 2019). This will enable you to either follow along or independently create your own images.
- It's not necessary, but if you want to bring your own personal inkjet printer, that will be fine.
- Commercial fabrics you might like to print on. Solids or fabrics that read as solids work best.
- Freezer paper. Although the roll works okay, I prefer the 8" x 10" freezer paper made for quilters, such as *Quilter's Freezer Paper Sheets* by C&T, is easier to work with.

CANCELLATIONS: Cancellation must be made **10 days** prior to the first day of class for a refund. Cancellation less than 10 days before the first day of class forfeits all registration monies paid. On occasion, the Stitchin' Post will cancel a class due to lack of registration. If the Stitchin' Post cancels this class, you may take a store credit or a refund. To minimize the chance that you will purchase your fabrics and supplies prior to a class that could cancel, we recommend that you call to confirm that the class has met its minimum enrollment and will go on as scheduled. Our recommendation is that you make class purchases within 10 days of the class start date.
