CLASS LEVEL – ALL

WORKSHOP DESCRIPTION

Put on your explorer hat and join the expedition into color discoveries. Jean will provide most of the materials to be used in the classroom while you create mock-ups and examples of how to use color in your creative endeavors. The use of color can create a mood, tell a story, and memorialize an occasion. Discover new ways to approach color in your life.

INSTRUCTIONS

A \$10 lab fee will be due to the instructor on the first day of class.

SUPPLY LIST

Jean will supply heavy paper, fabric, glue sticks, pens, magazines etc. for most of the assignments.

Please bring the following.

- paper and fabric cutting scissors
- 3 to 4 printed images of color combinations that you are attracted to. They can be cards, magazine images, snapshots, advertisements.
- On the second day, each of you will bring a palette of fabric that interests you. Each fabric should be cut into a 5” square. You can bring as many as you want, but think about how they might interact in a composition

CANCELLATIONS: Cancellation must be made **10 days** prior to the first day of class for a refund. Cancellation less than 10 days before the first day of class forfeits all registration monies paid. On occasion, the Stitchin' Post will cancel a class due to lack of registration. If the Stitchin' Post cancels this class, you may take a store credit or a refund. To minimize the chance that you will purchase your fabrics and supplies prior to a class that could cancel, we recommend that you call to confirm that the class has met its minimum enrollment and will go on as scheduled.
