CLASS LEVEL - CONFIDENT BEGINNER

WORKSHOP DESCRIPTION

Geese Migration is not your ordinary scrap quilt. In this class, you'll learn to use small pieces to create a lovely colorwash effect. You'll build confidence in color and fabric usage as you incorporate a variety of selections in exciting new ways.

INSTRUCTIONS

- Have a number of 2.5" squares cut so you can start playing right away. Try to disregard the print on the fabric and just look at the color. You will get lots of practice doing this in the workshop!
- Feel free to contact the instructor if you have any questions.
- A pattern for the quilt will be supplied on the day of the class.
- Instructor will bring lots of 2.5" precut squares so every student has access to lots of scrap options.

SUPPLY LIST

- Fabric
 - 2.5" x 26" (or longer) in 25 assorted solid colors for geese. Only about 6-8 of these colors will actually be needed for the class.
 - Lots of scraps that coordinate with your solids. The quilt requires a total of 375 - 2.5" squares and 125 - 2.5" x 4.5" rectangles. I suggest limiting the colors of your scraps to just a few colorways. For example, blue/green/purple or red/pink/orange.
- Working sewing machine and knowledge on how to use it
- Basic sewing supplies – seam ripper, pins, rotary cutter, etc.
- Marker (for marking lines on fabric)

CANCELLATIONS: Cancellation must be made **45 days** prior to the first day of class for a refund, less a \$25 non-refundable registration deposit. Cancellation less than 45 days before the first day of class forfeits all registration monies paid. On occasion, Stitchin' Post will cancel a class due to lack of registration. If Stitchin' Post cancels this class, you may take a store credit or a refund. To minimize the chance that you will purchase your fabrics and supplies prior to a class that could cancel, we recommend that you call to confirm that the class has met its minimum enrollment and will go on as scheduled. Our recommendation is that you make class purchases within 45 days of the class start date.

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
