CLASS LEVEL - CONFIDENT BEGINNER

WORKSHOP DESCRIPTION

Do you love, but avoid, the traditional one-patch? Handwork is wonderful, but let's explore an innovative machine technique, useful for any pattern that would typically be English paper pieced, without compromising the integrity of the original. We begin with hexagons, then move quickly to a Sunburst star (like in the pictured quilt, simplified for class). You'll enjoy having this in your bag of tricks!

SUPPLY LIST

- 10-15 fat quarters (or equivalent) ensuring you have high contrast (lights/darks/brights) and some fabrics that read as solids
- Pins
- Fabric scissors
- Rotary cutting tools
- Invisible monofilament thread
- Offset tweezers (optional)
- Straight pins
- Pinable personal ironing board (in which pins will stand straight up firmly). This can be a lightweight board with a layer of foam and batting covered with muslin, or a few layers of foam core glued together, or a piece of insulation covered with muslin, or a purchased board e.g. June Tailor's Cut and Press board. It should be about 12" x 18". (June Tailor's Cut & Press board available by special order at Stitchin' Post.)
- Personal craft iron, if you have one. (Mighty Steam Iron available at Stitchin' Post.)
- \$2 kit fee, payable to instructor. Kit includes pattern sheets, knife, glue, poster board.

CANCELLATIONS: Cancellation must be made **45 days** prior to the first day of class for a refund, less a \$25 non-refundable registration deposit. Cancellation less than 45 days before the first day of class forfeits all registration monies paid. On occasion, Stitchin' Post will cancel a class due to lack of registration. If Stitchin' Post cancels this class, you may take a store credit or a refund. To minimize the chance that you will purchase your fabrics and supplies prior to a class that could cancel, we recommend that you call to confirm that the class has met its minimum enrollment and will go on as scheduled. Our recommendation is that you make class purchases within 45 days of the class start date.

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
