WORKSHOP DESCRIPTION

These little handmade pals, created by Jennifer Evans, are perfect on the holiday mantel-piece, tree, or packages. But they'll celebrate any season cheerfully! Originally designed for fingering-weight yarn, we love them just as much a bit bigger in DK-weight yarn.

With elves, its certainly true that the more you make, the merrier! They'll naturally all turn out a little different, but you can make them even more various: Taller. Shorter. Plumper. Thinner. All green for St. Paddy's day. All pink for your Valentine. All white for a snowman with a smart black hat and coal buttons. Once you've got the hang of it, the only limit is your imagination. Knit up a whole neighborhood of wee elves using this wonderful Churchmouse Yarns pattern.

INSTRUCTIONS

The required pattern, Jolly Wee Elf by Churchmouse Yarn, is available at Stitchin' Post and on Ravelry

SUPPLY LIST FOR TINY WEE ELF

- Fingering yarn, colors and quantities per pattern
- US 1.5 (2.5MM) double-points (set of 5) or size to obtain gauge
- One or more flat metal washers per elf, approx. 1" outside diameter
- Wool or polyester stuffing
- One locking stitch marker
- Tapestry needle

SUPPLY LIST FOR TINY WEE ELF

- DK yarn, colors and quantities per pattern
- US 3 (3.25MM) double-points (set of 5) or size to obtain gauge
- Two or more flat metal washers per elf, approx. 1" outside diameter
- Wool or polyester stuffing
- One locking stitch marker
- Tapestry needle

CANCELLATIONS: Cancellation must be made 10 days prior to the first day of class for a refund. Cancellation less than 10 days before the first day of class forfeits all registration monies paid. On occasion, the Stitchin' Post will cancel a class due to lack of registration. If the Stitchin' Post cancels this class, you may take a store credit or a refund. To minimize the chance that you will purchase your fabrics and supplies prior to a class that could cancel, we recommend that you call to confirm that the class has met its minimum enrollment and will go on as scheduled. Our recommendation is that you make class purchases within 10 days of the class start date.
