#### **WORKSHOP DESCRIPTION**

Have you always wanted to try turned-edge applique? Then now is the time to learn how to use the amazing tools designed to help you turn the edges of even the tiniest of shapes easier and faster than basting by hand. Whether you are creating shapes for hand or machine stitching, the turned edges look beautiful and your work will last longer.



You'll create this charming design as you learn to work with the set of 2 Apliquick rods, 1 rod to hold large or tiny pieces and the other for turning the edges. You will also learn about Apliquick interfacing which has been specially designed to be the exact stiffness to allow you to achieve very fine detail, yet not make your applique look or feel stiff. You will work with Apliquick adhesive which is specifically formulated to hold the edges of your applique quickly the first time. This adhesive is acid and phosphate-free, so no damage will be done to your fabric.

The fun doesn't stop there! You will also learn how to prepare your fabrics for applique, how to handle convex and concave curves, inner and outer points, circles, how to reverse applique, how to make stems and much, much more. Join us for a fun class and create beautiful applique the Apliquick way!

**Note:** If you would like to learn the Apliquick method but prefer to hand applique Shelley will be happy to show you her favourite hand applique stitch.

#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

When selecting your fabrics, think of flowers, leaves, and stems. The pieces do not need to be cut exactly. If you like, bring larger pieces to fussy cut.

#### **SUPPLY LIST**

- Sewing machine, including foot control and cord
- Fabric
  - Background 15" x 13" rectangle - This fabric can be plain, print or pieced
  - Birds 7" x 5" rectangle
  - Leaves 20" x 2" rectangle
  - Berries 8" x 2" rectangle
  - Flower 5" x 5" rectangle
  - Flower Centre 2" x 2" square

**KEEP GOING...THERE'S MORE!**

- Roof 6" x 5" rectangle
- Bias stems 10" x 10" square
- Birdhouse 8" x 5"
- Open toe embroidery foot
- 70/10 or 80/12 Microtex or Organ HLx5 needles
- .5mm mechanical pencil
- Black .5 Pigma Micron by Sakura or Sharpie Ultra Fine Point pen
- Fabric scissors
- Seam Align glue + Easy Press Fabric Treatment + Easy Press Pen
- Basic sewing supplies
- Sulky Polyester Monofilament or equivalent
- Appliquick rods
- Appliquick fusible interfacing
- Bohin or equivalent glue stick
- Quilter's No-Melt Press Bars by Collins or equivalent

**CANCELLATIONS:** Cancellation must be made **45 days** prior to the first day of class for a refund, less a \$25 non-refundable registration deposit. Cancellation less than 45 days before the first day of class forfeits all registration monies paid. On occasion, Stitchin' Post will cancel a class due to lack of registration.
