WORKSHOP DESCRIPTION

Starting with your own inspirational photo of choice (landscape, animal, still life, person, event, or abstract) you'll enlarge your photo onto fabric and create a fabulous piece of wall art using Tsukineko Inks.

You will learn how to control the inks, creating value changes, intensity, sharpness of line, and texture. June will share color blending and other tricks, and you'll surprise yourself with how easily you successfully recreate your photo.

SUPPLY LIST

All supplies are available through Stitchin' Post, where Tsukineko Inks are available year 'round.

- Inspirational photo (your choice of landscape, animal, still life, person, event, or abstract)
- Pencil & Eraser
- Freezer Paper
- Masking Tape
- Scissors
- 6 Tsukineko inks – I like to make sure to have cool grey and black (available at Stitchin' Post)
- 2 brush tip Fantastix applicators with caps for each color of ink
- 1 yard of tight weave fabric. I prefer white Ultra Sateen by Kauffman or white Pimatex by Kauffman, or a light (white) batik.
- ¼ yard muslin

CANCELLATIONS: Cancellation must be made **10 days** prior to the first day of class for a refund. Cancellation less than 10 days before the first day of class forfeits all registration monies paid. On occasion, the Stitchin' Post will cancel a class due to lack of registration. If the Stitchin' Post cancels this class, you may take a store credit or a refund. To minimize the chance that you will purchase your fabrics and supplies prior to a class that could cancel, we recommend that you call to confirm that the class has met its minimum enrollment and will go on as scheduled. Our recommendation is that you make class purchases within 10 days of the class start date.
