WORKSHOP DESCRIPTION

Want to learn to print your own repeat-patterned fabric to use in your craft and DIY projects? Valori Wells, designer, quilter, maker, and Stitchin' Post co-owner will guide you through creating a repeated block for printing your own fabric. We will explore squares, diamonds, triangles and clam shells.

INSTRUCTIONS

Most tools and materials are provided, including two blocks to be carved, carving and printing tools, and printing ink. You'll leave with your own custom-printed fabric!

SUPPLY LIST

- Inspiration for blocks – photographs, magazine clippings, whatever inspires you
- Pencil / Ruler
- Fabric for printing - a minimum of a fat $\frac{1}{4}$ in size and 2 yards in total – solid-like fabrics are best for repeated designs. Bring lights and darks to see how your block changes with color and shade of fabric.
- Old shirt or paint apron - something you don't mind getting inky
- An open mind and creative spirit!

CANCELLATIONS: Cancellation must be made **10 days** prior to the first day of class for a refund. Cancellation less than 10 days before the first day of class forfeits all registration monies paid. On occasion, the Stitchin' Post will cancel a class due to lack of registration. If the Stitchin' Post cancels this class, you may take a store credit or a refund. To minimize the chance that you will purchase your fabrics and supplies prior to a class that could cancel, we recommend that you call to confirm that the class has met its minimum enrollment and will go on as scheduled. Our recommendation is that you make class purchases within 10 days of the class start date.

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
