WORKSHOP DESCRIPTION

What knitter doesn't dream of having her own sheep? These handknit friends, created by Freshy Millsap, are a wee bit easier to care for than a real herd. Choose stockinette or garter stitch for fleecy variety—and knit your own flock! In this class, you'll use a starter kit to knit 3-4 larger Wee Sheep in a DK-weight. Your handknit herd is sure to grow and grow. Paula will guide you using this popular pattern from Churchmouse Yarns.

INSTRUCTIONS

- Required pattern, Woolly Wee Sheep by Churchmouse Yarn, available at Stitchin' Post and on Ravelry
- Required kit, available in class - \$12 includes yarn, (including waste yarn for provisional cast on), neck trim and bells for 3-4 sheep
- **SUPPLY LIST FOR LARGER WEE SHEEP**
- US 3 (3.25mm) set of 5 double-point needles, or size to obtain gauge
- US 1 (2.25mm) set of 5 double-point needles, or 2 sizes smaller than gauge needle
- US D/3 (3.25mm) crochet hook
- Wool or polyester stuffing
- 8 locking markers
- Fine darning needle

CANCELLATIONS: Cancellation must be made 10 days prior to the first day of class for a refund. Cancellation less than 10 days before the first day of class forfeits all registration monies paid. On occasion, the Stitchin' Post will cancel a class due to lack of registration. If the Stitchin' Post cancels this class, you may take a store credit or a refund. To minimize the chance that you will purchase your fabrics and supplies prior to a class that could cancel, we recommend that you call to confirm that the class has met its minimum enrollment and will go on as scheduled.
