Confident beginner

WORKSHOP DESCRIPTION

Using thickened dyes, you will paint onto fabric. The use of resists will play into this process while you create your masterpiece. June will demonstrate the use of many techniques for you to experiment with in this one-day workshop. You will go home with a painting or two and written instructions on how to wash your piece and prepare it to be used.

INSTRUCTIONS

You will receive a kit in class containing the proper fabrics and thickened dyes. Be prepared to pay a lab fee of \$15 for these supplies. If you choose to bring additional fabrics, then used fabric prepared to dye soaked in soda ash. I prefer either Pimatex or a tight weave sateen.

SUPPLY LIST

- Painters tape
- 4 paint brushes: small, medium, large, and extra large
- Rubber gloves
- Apron or paint shirt
- An image or two to draw onto the fabric
- 4 kitchen size white plastic garbage bags without texture
- Freezer paper
- Paper scissors
- Face mask to cover nose and mouth

CANCELLATIONS: Cancellation must be made 10 days prior to the first day of class for a refund. Cancellation less than 10 days before the first day of class forfeits all registration monies paid. On occasion, the Stitchin' Post will cancel a class due to lack of registration. If the Stitchin' Post cancels this class, you may take a store credit or a refund. To minimize the chance that you will purchase your fabrics and supplies prior to a class that could cancel, we recommend that you call to confirm that the class has met its minimum enrollment and will go on as scheduled. Our recommendation is that you make class purchases within 10 days of the class start date.
