WORKSHOP DESCRIPTION

In this introductory workshop you will learn how to permanently print the images of leaves onto silk fabric, using only the natural pigments found within each leaf. The shapes, colors, and even textures of leaves can be captured through a process with low environmental impact. This use of real leaves to create unique designs allows you to connect with nature in a unique and rewarding way.

You will be led step-by-step through two different processes of treating fabric and/or leaves to create different styles of leaf prints. You will create two leaf printed silk scarves (11 xx 60 inches) as well as a similarly sized piece of cotton fabric. Additionally, you will go home with detailed handouts including instructions, resources for supplies, and all the information you need to continue experimenting with this fascinating process at home.

The cost of the workshop includes two blank scarves, fabric and all dyeing supplies, including leaves. This class is perfect for beginners as well as those with some experience who wish to learn new techniques and gain more expertise in a supportive setting.

SUPPLY LIST

- All materials are supplied by instructor.
- Wear a smock, full apron, or old work clothes.

CANCELLATIONS: Cancellation must be made **10 days** prior to the first day of class for a refund. Cancellation less than 10 days before the first day of class forfeits all registration monies paid. On occasion, the Stitchin' Post will cancel a class due to lack of registration. If the Stitchin' Post cancels this class, you may take a store credit or a refund.
