WORKSHOP DESCRIPTION

You will be making a small quilt or table runner while learning the basics of quilt making. The size of the quilt depends on your needs. The basic size is a six-block quilt.

INSTRUCTIONS

ATTENDANCE TO THE FIRST CLASS IS MANDATORY

SUPPLY LIST

Basic Sewing Supplies:

- Sewing machine in good working order with new needle (and owner's manual is sometimes helpful)
- rotary cutter (medium or large)
- cutting mat (18" x 24" or 24" x 36" depending on your work area space at home)
- ruler(6" x 24: and 6-1/2" square Omni rulers)
- fabric scissors
- thread
- pencil
- pins
- seam ripper

Fabric Requirements:

- Choose 1 yard of theme (main) fabric and six different 1/2 yard pieces that go with your theme fabric and have contrast in values with light, medium, and dark for piecing and outside border.
- You do not need to limit your choices of fabric to these – you may use more, but this is a starting point.
- The theme fabric is your “starting” fabric, one that you use as a basic fabric, with other fabrics chosen to go with this one. Be sure you select fabrics that are the same mood or style as your theme fabric.

KEEP GOING...THERE'S A LITTLE MORE!

Be sure you know how to:

- Thread your machine
- Wind the bobbin
- Put the bobbin in the bobbin case correctly
- Change the needle

CANCELLATIONS: Cancellation must be made **14 days** prior to the first day of class for a refund. Cancellation less than 14 days before the first day of class forfeits all registration monies paid. On occasion, the Stitchin' Post will cancel a class due to lack of registration. If the Stitchin' Post cancels this class, you may take a store credit or a refund.
