WORKSHOP DESCRIPTION

The idea of this class is to perfect piecing techniques and learn new cutting shortcuts, while making a quilt of the size you desire.

You will be learning how to use both the half-square triangle and the quarter-square triangle rulers to help your cutting and piecing skills become more accurate. We will be making 6" blocks. You will be shown how they will "fit" inside larger Sawtooth Stars or other 12" finished blocks if you desire. You will be shown various settings for the blocks, and you will choose your own setting.

SUPPLY LIST

Basic Sewing Supplies:

- Sewing machine in good working order with new needle (and owner's manual is sometimes helpful)
- Rotary cutter (medium or large)
- Cutting mat (18" x 24" or 24" x 36" depending on your work area space at home)
- Rulers - 6"(or 6-1/2") x 24" and 6-1/2" square Omni rulers
- Fabric scissors
- Thread
- Pencil
- Pins
- Seam ripper
- Lunch and water bottle

The following rulers are needed for class:

- 96/L Omnigrid Ruler
- 98/L Omnigrid Ruler

The "L" means it is larger. Each of these rulers is available as a smaller one or a larger (L) size. Pick one or the other size, but you do need one of each.

KEEP GOING...THERE'S A LITTLE MORE!

Fabric Requirements:

Select a theme, and then choose several fabrics to go with this theme. Bring 2 ½-3 yards total of several fabrics for the “piecing of the blocks”. You may want a bit more! This is a guesstimate of yardage and should give you enough to work with.

CANCELLATIONS: Cancellation must be made **14 days** prior to the first day of class for a refund. Cancellation less than 14 days before the first day of class forfeits all registration monies paid. On occasion, the Stitchin' Post will cancel a class due to lack of registration. If the Stitchin' Post cancels this class, you may take a store credit or a refund. To minimize the chance that you will purchase your fabrics and supplies prior to a class that could cancel, we recommend that you call to confirm that the class has met its minimum enrollment and will go on as scheduled. Our recommendation is that you make class purchases within 10 days of the class start date.

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
