## WORKSHOP DESCRIPTION

Make a statement in an easy sew, comfortable and casual shirt using flannel, denim, rayon, or a fabric of your choice. It is a great top for all seasons. Compliment the look with four buttons and wear this top with minimal time invested. The pattern features a front pleat, cuffed sleeves and back button details. Add faux decorative buttons down the back or leave it open!

## INSTRUCTIONS

You will need additional fabric if your fabric is plaid or directional.

## SUPPLY LIST

- “Button Back Shirt” pattern by Indygo Essentials (available at the Stitchin Post)
- 3 yards of fabric
- 1 yard garment quality interfacing 20” wide
- Polyester thread to match your fabric
- Buttons: 4 @ 1/2” – 3/4”
- A sewing machine in good working order (power cord, foot pedal)
- Machine accessories and operation manual
- A new needle or two compatible with the thread you will be using
- Any of the machine feet like zipper, walking foot, 1/4", zig zag, etc.
- Extra bobbins
- Rotary cutter, mat and acrylic ruler(s)
- Fabric shears
- Seam ripper
- Small, sharp scissors
- Fabric marking tools or pens
- Pins
- Tape measure
- Hand sewing needles
- Lunch and water bottle

**CANCELLATIONS:** Cancellation must be made **14 days** prior to the first day of class for a refund. Cancellation less than 14 days before the first day of class forfeits all registration monies paid. On occasion, the Stitchin' Post will cancel a class due to lack of registration. If the Stitchin' Post cancels this class, you may take a store credit or a refund.
