BEFORE CUTTING AND SEWING, PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS TO FAMILIARIZE YOURSELF WITH THEM.
A 1/4" seam allowance is used throughout.

Materials Needed and Cutting Instructions

(all measurements based on accurate cutting, 1/4" seam allowance, and 42" wide strips)

Version I fabrics are Ashton Road cottons

Version II fabrics are Ashton Road cotton flannels

Materials, Version I:

All the fabrics are from Ashton Road cottons and use 1/4 yard cuts, *not fat quarters*.

- A - 1/4 yard AVW-14840-112 Raspberry
- B - 1/3 yard AVW-14840-281 Pomegranate
- C - 1/3 yard AVW-14840-47 Grass
- D - 1/4 yard AVW-14842-129 Marigold
- E - 1/3 yard AVW-14842-40 Emerald
- F - 1/3 yard AVW-14842-19 Orchid
- G - 1/4 yard AVW-114842-226 Peony
- H - 1/3 yard AVW-14843-332 Persimmon
- I - 5/8 yard AVW-14839-193 Summer
- J - 1 yard AVW-14838-267 Adventure

To complete the quilt:

- 1/2 yard AVW-14840-112 Raspberry for binding
- 3 yards backing if running widthwise,
or 3 1/2 yards if running lengthwise
- 54" x 60" quilt batting

Materials, Version II:

All the fabrics are from Ashton Road flannels and use 1/4 yard cuts, *not fat quarters*.

- A - 1/4 yard AVWF-14843-305 Graphite
- B - 1/3 yard AVWF-14840-2 Black
- C - 1/3 yard AVWF-14840-81 Turquoise
- D - 1/4 yard AVWF-14843-9 Navy
- E - 1/3 yard AVWF-14840-35 Sprig
- F - 1/3 yard AVWF-14843-94 Cardinal
- G - 1/4 yard AVWF-14840-9 Navy
- H - 1/3 yard AVWF-14843-43 Leaf
- I - 5/8 yard AVWF-14841-327 Laguna
- J - 1 3/8 yard AVWF-14837-269 Park

To complete the quilt:

- 1/2 yard AVWF-14840-2 Black for binding
- 3 yards backing if running widthwise,
3 1/2 yards if running lengthwise
- 54" x 60" quilt batting

Cutting Directions For Both Versions:

<i>Fabric</i>	<i># Large (7 1/2") Triangles to Cut</i>	<i># Small (4 1/2") Triangles to Cut</i>
A	2	6
B	4	6
C	4	7
D	2	6
E	4	6
F	4	7
G	2	6
H	4	6

Additional Cutting, Version 1:

Cut 3 - 10 1/2" x 42" strips using AVW-14839-267 Adventure.
Sew together lengthwise into one long strip.
Cut 2 - 10 1/2" x 48 1/2" strips for Row 3 and Row 6.

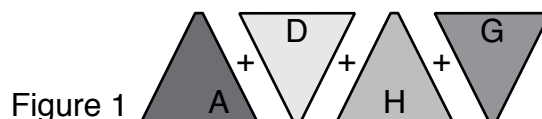
Cut 3 - 6 1/2" x 42" strips using AVW-14839-193 Summer.
Sew together lengthwise into one long strip.
Cut 2 - 6 1/2" x 48 1/2" strips for Row 2 and Row 7.

Additional Cutting, Version 2:

Fussy-Cut 2 - 10 1/2" x 48 1/2" *lengthwise* strips
(parallel to the selvage) using AVWF-14837-269 Park
for Row 3 and Row 6.

Cut 3 - 6 1/2" x 42" strips using AVWF-14841-327 Laguna.
Sew together lengthwise into one long strip.
Cut 2 - 6 1/2" x 48 1/2" strips for Row 2 and Row 7.

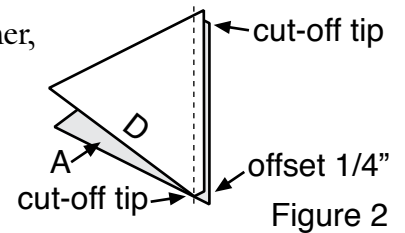
Note: All sides of the triangles are not equal – When sewing, be sure to keep the cut-off tips of the triangles alternating at the top or the bottom of the rows, as shown. **Figure 1.**



Sewing Instructions, Version I:

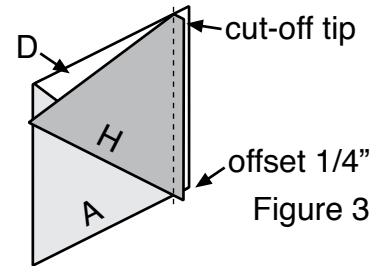
1. Referring to the illustration, start with Row 1 – the small triangles, sew a D triangle to an A triangle. Place the two triangles right sides together, D on top of A. Offset the D triangle 1/4" and sew. **Figure 2.**

Press toward A.



Layer a H triangle on top of D. Offset the H triangle 1/4" and sew. **Figure 3.** Press toward D.

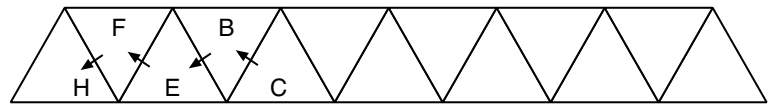
Continue working across the row in this manner, sewing and pressing as you go. This will help keep your row straight.



2. Referring to the illustration, sew Row 4 -- the large triangles, sew a F triangle to a H triangle. Place the two triangles right sides together, F on top of H. Offset the H triangle 1/4" and sew.

Continue making Row 4, sewing and pressing toward the triangle on the bottom as you go.

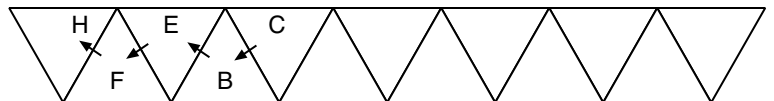

Sew Row 5, again using the large triangles.

This time press toward the triangle you just added after sewing each triangle. **Figure 5.**

Doing this, your seams will "nest" together when you sew Row 4 to Row 5.



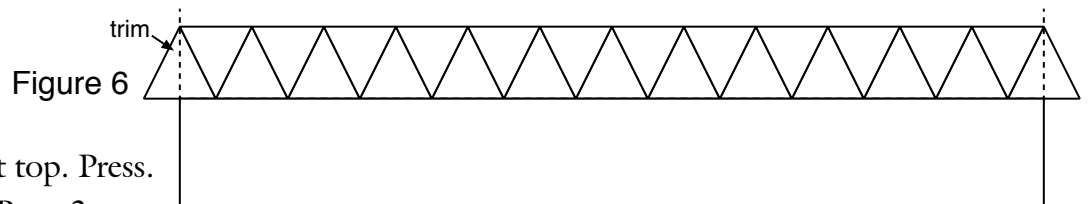
Sew Row 4 to Row 5. Press and set aside.

3. Referring to the illustration, and using small triangles, sew Row 8 together.

4. Sew the rows together: Sew Row 1 to Row 2.

Trim the A triangle at the beginning of the row and the G triangle at the other end of the row even with Row 2 after they are sewn together. **Figure 6.** Press.



Sew Row 3 to the quilt top. Press.

Sew Row 4/Row 5 to Row 3.

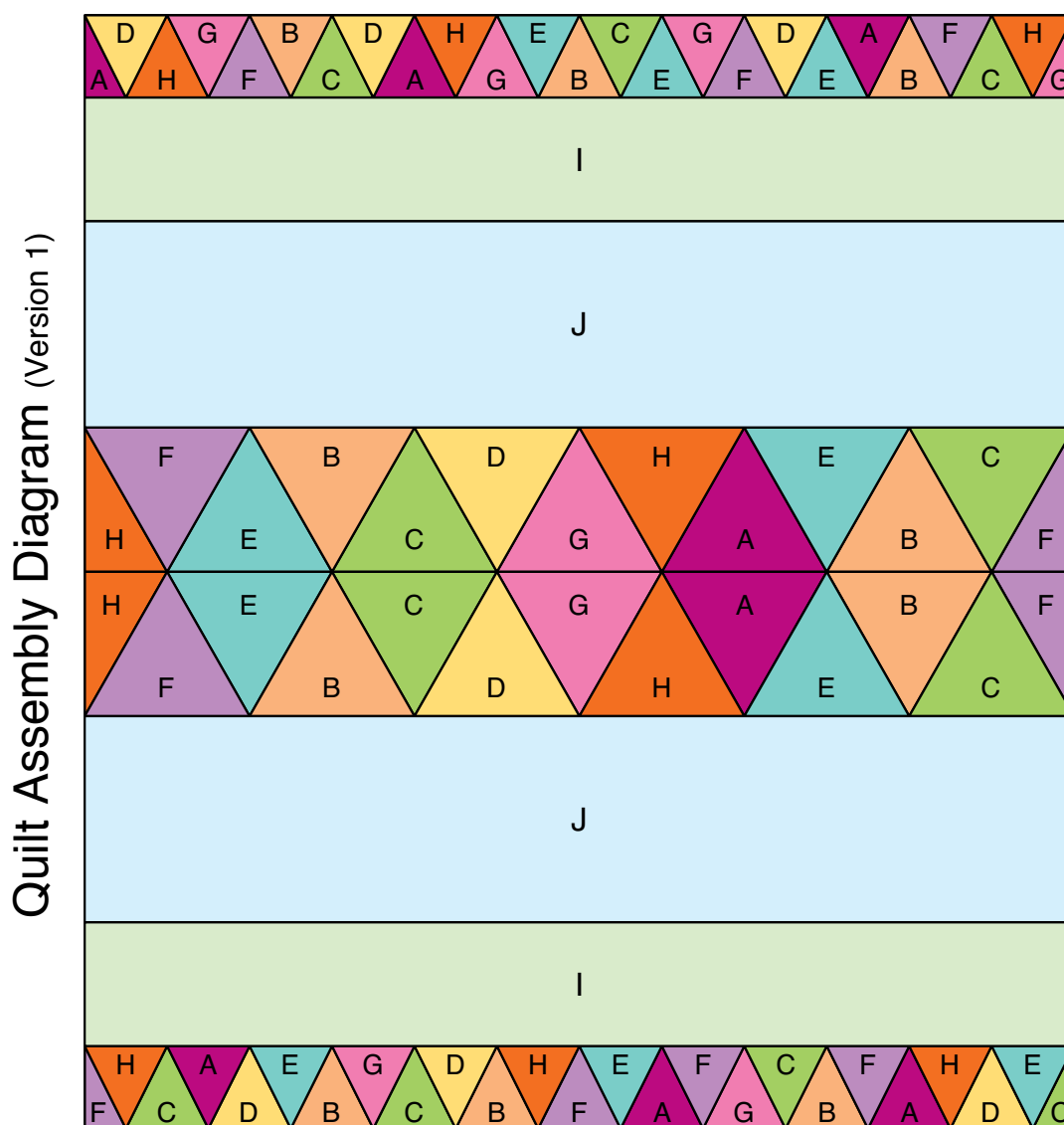
Again you will be trimming off the H triangles and the F triangles even with Row 3. Press.

Continue sewing the quilt top together, and trimming Row 8 after it has been sewn and pressed.

5. Layer, quilt, and finish the quilt.

Sewing Instructions, Version II:

1. Referring to the illustration for Version II, and following Version I directions, sew the small triangles together to make Row 1.
2. In Rows 3 and 4 you may want to rearrange your large triangles, scramble the arrangement up a bit.
Plan your arrangement for each row and sew together following Version I directions -- or follow the illustration for Version II and sew together.
3. Starting with step 3 of Version I, continue piecing the rows and sewing the quilt top together.



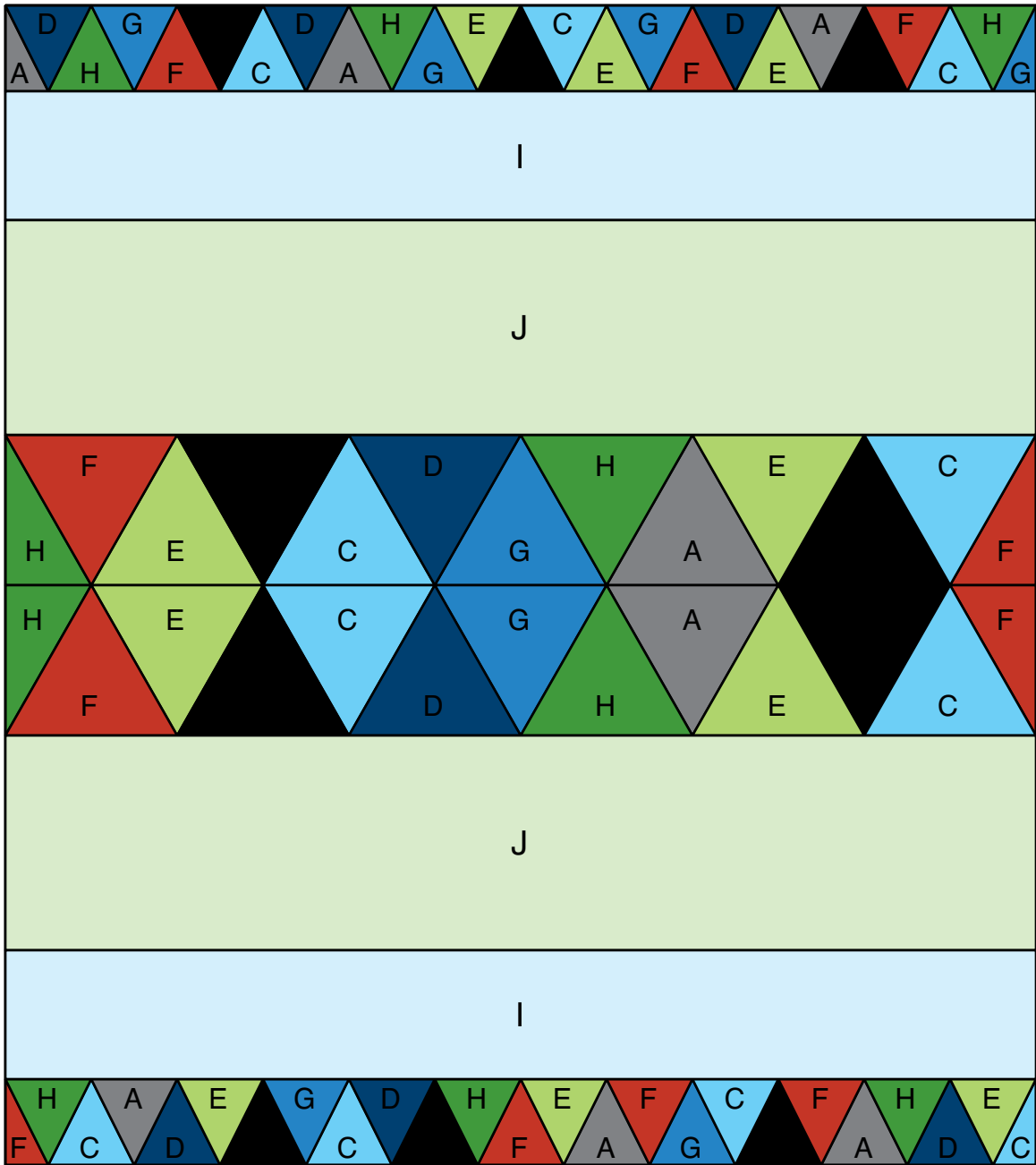
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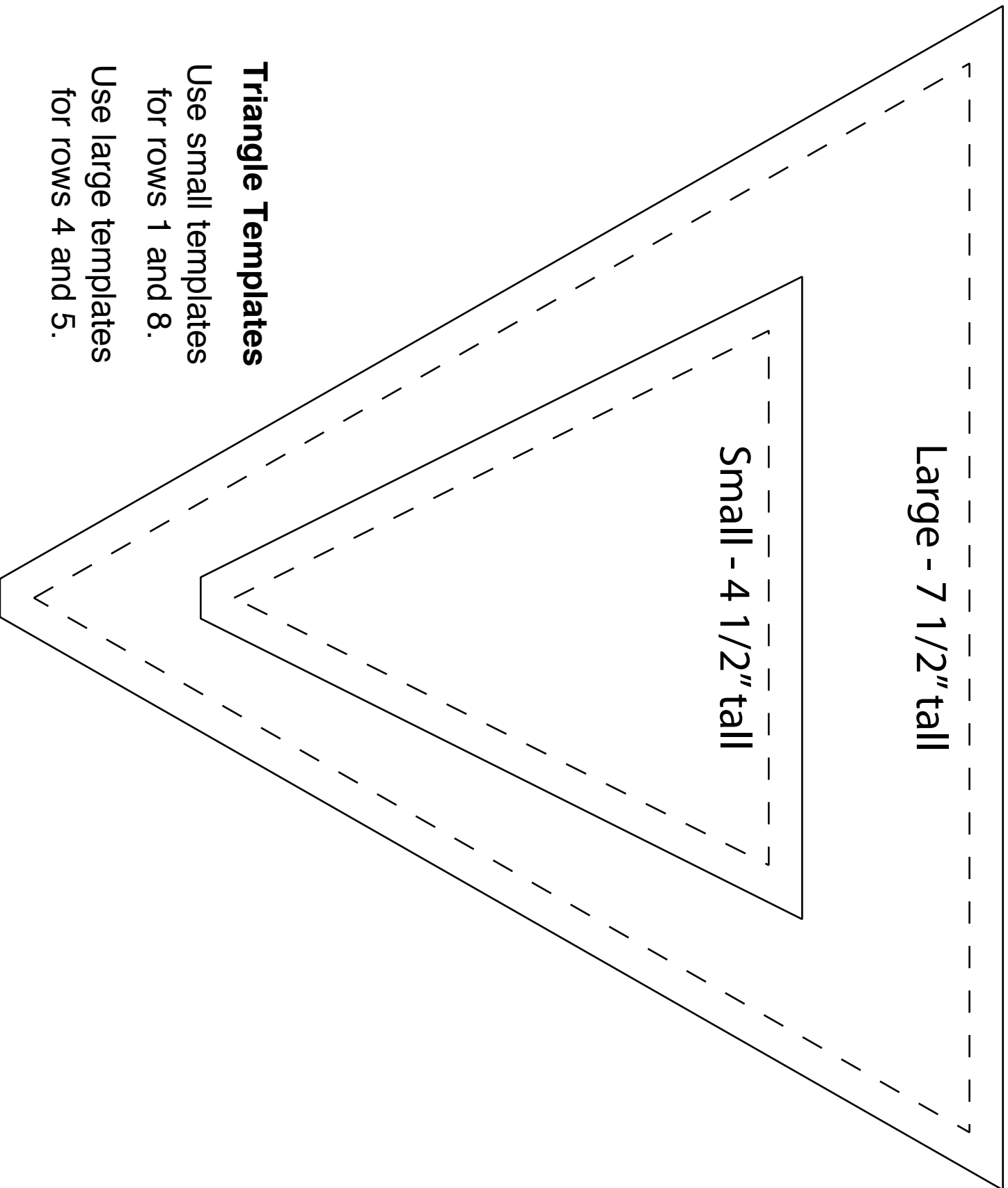


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Quilt Assembly Diagram (Version 2)

for rows 1 and 8.

Use large templates
for rows 4 and 5.
