A 1/4" seam allowance is used throughout.**

Materials Needed and Cutting Instructions

(all measurements based on accurate cutting, 1/4" seam allowance, and 42" wide strips)

All the fabrics are from Blueprint Basics, except the solids – they are Kona Cottons by Robert Kaufman.

1 - Blueprint Basics Autumn Collection
Fat Quarter Bundle FQ-812-13

Plus

1/3 yard AVW-14541-184 Charcoal
2 yards AVW-14543-316 Coastal Fog

To complete the quilt, you will also need:

1/2 yard AVW-14541-184 Charcoal for binding
4 1/2 yards backing
56" x 80" quilt batting

*The FQ-812-13 Fat Quarter Bundle

Cutting Instructions

From each of the following fabrics cut 2 - 8 1/4" squares. Cut into quarter square triangles.



K001 – 136 Basil

K001 – 1470 Amber

AVW – 14538 – 311 Turkish Sea

AVW – 14539 – 45 Moss

AVW – 14539 – 62 Indigo

AVW – 14541 – Bamboo

From each of the following fabrics cut 3 - 8 ¼” squares. Cut into quarter square triangles.



K001 – 151 Cyan

K001 – 7 Tomato

AVW – 14544-319 Honeysuckle

AVW – 14540 – 117 Apple

AVW – 14542 – Concord Grape

From AVW 14541-184 cut 7 - 8 ¼” squares. Cut into quarter square triangles.



When you are ready for binding, cut 7 - 2 ¼” strips.

From the background fabric AVW – 14543 – 316 Coastal Fog, cut the following:

A – cut 2 - 18 ½” squares.

B – cut 2 - 14 7/8” squares, cut into half square triangles.



C – cut 3 - 4 1/2” x 28 1/2” rectangles.

D – cut 7 - 4 3/8” squares, cut into half square triangles.

E – cut 4 - 8 ¼” squares, cut into quarter square triangles.



Border rectangles – cut 3 - 4 x 42” strips.

F – cut 5 - 4” x 7 ½” rectangles.

G – cut 2 - 4” x 4 ½” rectangles.

H – cut 5 - 4” x 9” rectangles.

I – cut 5 - 4” x 13 ½” rectangles.

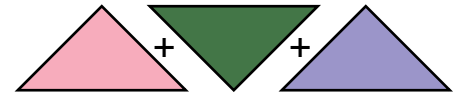

Sewing Instructions

A ¼” seam allowance is used throughout. Press seams on a regular basis.

- Following the Quilt Assembly Diagram, arrange the half square triangles, beginning with column 1 on the right hand side of the diagram. They will be sewn together in vertical columns (these are numbered from right to left on the schematic). When you are pleased with the arrangement of colors, sew the triangles in column 1. **Figure 1.**

- Complete columns 1 through 4 for section 1.

Sew the columns together.

Add B to the top and bottom of the section.

Complete section 2, sewing 5 through 8 in the same manner.

Add B to the top and bottom.

Sew sections 1 and 2 together. Add C to the top and bottom.

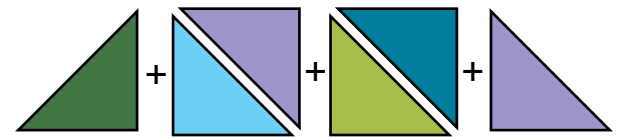

- Section 3: The half square triangles are assembled in diagonal rows. **Figures 2 & 3.** Complete the two rows and sew them together. Add B. Complete the second part of section 3. Sew the two parts together. Add C to the left side. Sew an A square to the top and bottom of section 3. Sew section 3 to the rest of the quilt.

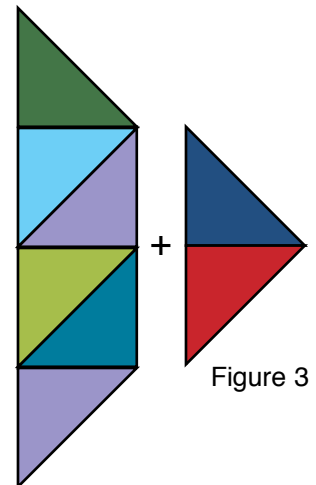
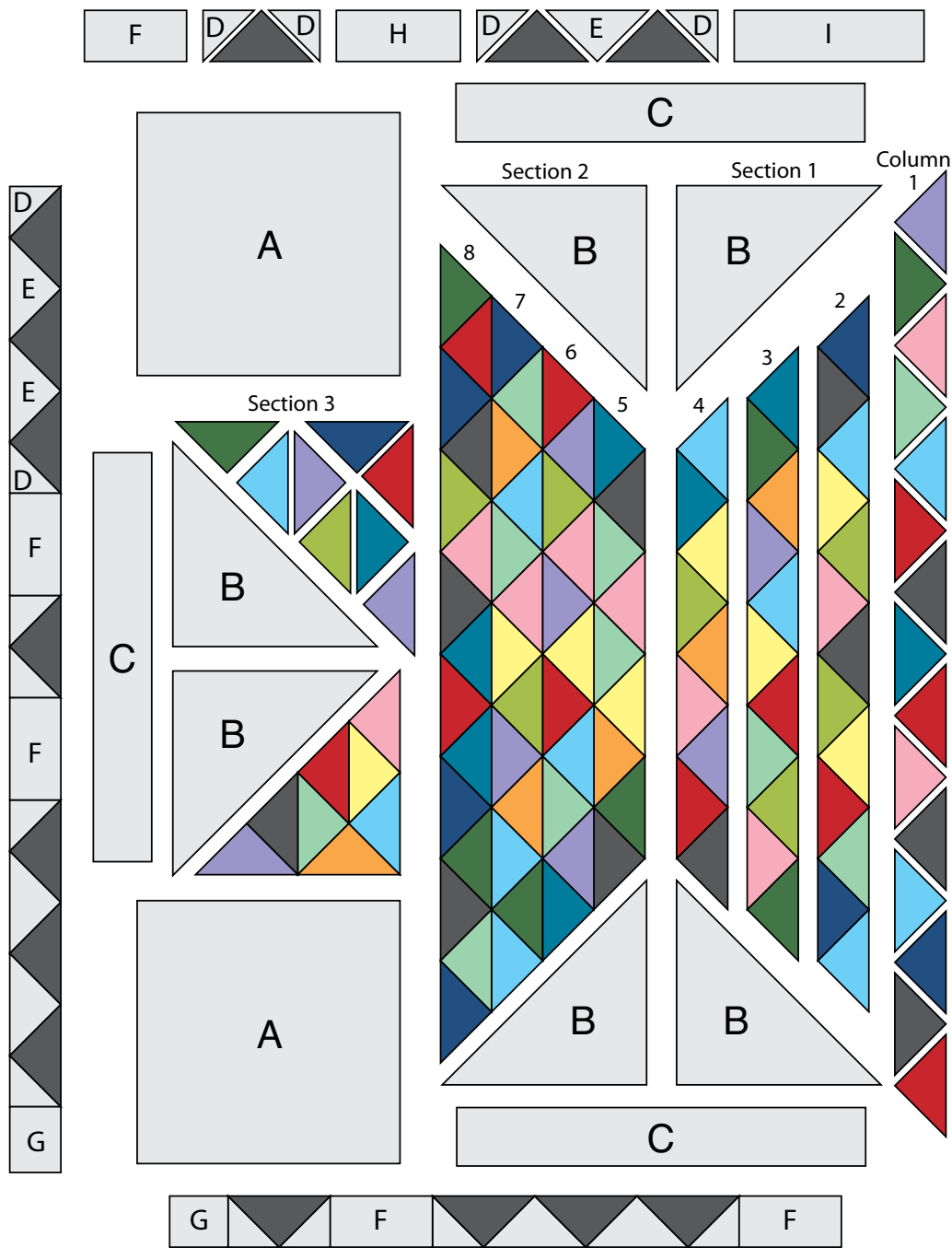

- Beginning with the bottom border and following the Quilt Assembly Diagram, arrange the border pieces and stitch together. Add to the quilt.

5. Follow the same procedure and complete the side border, then the top border. Add them to the quilt.
6. Layer the quilt and machine or hand quilt. Add binding.
